BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The class action settlement agreement and the fee settlement agreement negotiated between King County and the plaintiffs in *Dupuis, et al. v. King County*, No. 02-2-08317-0 SEA, attached to this ordinance and by this reference made a part of this ordinance, are hereby approved and adopted in substantially the same form as attached.

SECTION 2. Upon final approval of the class action settlement agreement and

the fee settlement agreement by the superior court of the state of Washington, the executive is directed to implement the terms of the agreements.
