



nationwide search through a merit-based selection process, and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the county and its citizens and is critical to the effective running of OLEO that an interim director be appointed as successor to the current director of OLEO while a nationwide search for qualified candidates for the position can be conducted and concluded, and

WHEREAS, effective September 15, 2020, a new director of OLEO will be serving on an interim basis as successor, until a new director is appointed by the council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The council directs the council chief of staff to take the steps necessary to conduct a nationwide search to identify potential candidates so the council can appoint a new director of OLEO to a four-year term in accordance with K.C.C. 2.75.030 and Section 265 of the King County Charter.

B. The appointment of Adrienne Wat as the successor and interim director of the office of law enforcement oversight, effective September 15, 2020, is confirmed. While serving as interim director of the office of law enforcement oversight, Adrienne Wat will receive a temporary salary adjustment to range 133 step 7.
