AN ORDINANCE authorizing the King County executive to enter into a lease agreement with The Center for Wooden Boats, as tenant, for county-owned land located at 1445 N. Northlake Pl, Seattle, Washington, in council district four.

STATEMENT OF FACTS:

1. The facilities management division, in partnership with Metro transit department, determined that the county should award a lease of county-owned land and facilities located at 1445 N Northlake Pl, Seattle, Washington.
2. The facilities management division and Metro transit department successfully negotiated a lease for the county-owned land and facilities with The Center for Wooden Boats.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The executive is authorized to execute a lease for the county-owned land and facilities with The Center for Wooden Boats, substantially in the form of Attachment A to this ordinance, and to take all actions necessary to implement the terms of the lease.
