SECTION 1. The memorandum of agreement regarding Vision Plan Enhancement negotiated by and between King County and Amalgamated Transit Union, Local 587 (Department of Transportation - Transit) representing employees in the department of transportation, which is Attachment A to this ordinance, is hereby
