WHEREAS, King County is dedicated to exploring with the state new ideas for sustained funding for critical services including transportation and transit, affordable housing, behavioral health and crisis response, public safety, and flood protection, and

WHEREAS, the King County council and the King County executive will continue to review legislative developments for possible revisions of King County's 2024 state legislative program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County council adopts the King County 2024 Legislative Priorities, Attachment A to this motion, as King County's highest priorities for action in the 2024 legislative session of the Washington state Legislature.
