WHEREAS, the report describes the staffing levels necessary to increase the sheriff's office visibility through neighborhood patrols in the unincorporated area of each sheriff precinct as compared to current reactive policing methods, and

WHEREAS, the report includes a feasibility assessment of establishing a taskforce or roundtable bringing together representatives from each unincorporated sheriff precinct and community leaders to foster collaboration and trust in furtherance of community policing, and

WHEREAS, the report includes a description of the resources and estimated time necessary to implement a community policing model in the unincorporated area of each sheriff precinct, and

WHEREAS, the report includes a description of obstacles to implement a community policing model in the unincorporated area of each of the sheriff precincts and recommended methods to overcome the obstacles;
