BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The memorandum of agreement negotiated by and between King County and the Washington State Nurses Association representing employees in the department of adult and juvenile detention and in the department of public health, which is Attachment A to this ordinance, is hereby approved and
