



vacancy occurs, the legislative authority of King County, which is the King County council, shall appoint a qualified person to fill the vacancy, and

WHEREAS, the Vashon/Maury Island community council is no longer operating and is listed in the Washington state records of nonprofit corporations as having been inactive since September 2013, and its records, if they still exist, cannot be located, and

WHEREAS, Jan Stephens lives in a home on Vashon Island that is about a nine-minute drive from the ferry terminal, has commuted from Vashon Island for thirty-seven years, and for more than five years has fought to maintain ferry service to Vashon Island, and

WHEREAS, Jan Stephens was appointed to the Vashon ferry advisory committee by the Vashon/Maury Island community council and believes that his appointment was more than four years ago, that his term expired more than ninety days ago, and that no one has been appointed to replace him, and

WHEREAS, in reference to the statutory requirement in RCW 47.60.310 that “not more than two members of any terminal-area committee may be from the same political party at the time of their appointment,” Jan Stephens generally votes Republican, but in any case votes for the candidate he considers most qualified, and

WHEREAS, Jan Stephens would like to be reappointed to the Vashon ferry advisory committee so that the Vashon Island community will continue to have a means of expressing its views to the management of Washington state ferries about the ferry service that is being provided to the community;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

Jan Stephens, who resides on Vashon Island, which is in council district eight, is hereby reappointed to the Vashon ferry advisory committee to a three-year term to expire on June 30, 2019.
