



a report and motion on the status of the stabilization of for the countywide financial and budget system by June 30, 2013, and

WHEREAS, the report on the stabilization of the financial and budget systems is a joint report from the finance and business operations division, the business resource center, the human resources division and the office of performance, strategy and budget, and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 17476 contains language in Section 62, Proviso P2, directing a strategy and plan to annually inventory, assess and report on the benefits realized by the implementation of new business processes and systems resulting from the Accountable Business Transformation project, and

WHEREAS, the King County executive has transmitted to the council a report that contains the required information responding to Ordinance 17476, Section 61, Proviso P1, and Section 62, Proviso P2, including:

1. A review of each system's ability to support county business processes based on metrics for measuring stabilization;
2. A description of the 2012 year-end closing process and lessons learned for the upcoming 2013 year-end closing; and
3. A description of how the county is realizing benefits now and in the future from its investment in new technology systems;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The council acknowledges receipt of the executive's response to the 2013 Budget Ordinance 17476, Section 61, Proviso P1, and Section 62, Provisos P2, related to the finance and business operations division and the business resource center, respectively, which is enclosed as Attachment A to this motion.

The proviso response is hereby accepted and the \$300,000 currently held in reserve in Ordinance 17476, Section 61, finance and business operations division, is hereby released.
