



WHEREAS, RCW 42.12.070(4) provides that, "If a governing body fails to appoint a qualified person to fill a vacancy within ninety days of the occurrence of the vacancy, the authority of the governing body to fill the vacancy shall cease and the county legislative authority of the county in which all or the largest geographic portion of the city, town, or special district is located shall appoint a qualified person to fill the vacancy," and

WHEREAS, King County is the legislative authority of the county for the Sammamish Plateau water and sewer district and, in accordance with RCW 42.12.070(5), is authorized to appoint, within one hundred and eighty days of the occurrence of the vacancy, a qualified person to fill the vacancy, and

WHEREAS, King County's one-hundred-eighty-day time limit expires July 4, 2009, and the authority to fill the vacancy would thereafter reside with the governor of the state of Washington unless King County acted to fill the vacancy before the governor's action, and

WHEREAS, Robert Abbott has been recommended to fill the unexpired term until the next general election for the district, and

WHEREAS, Robert Abbott meets the qualifications to serve as a member of the board of commissioners of Sammamish Plateau water and sewer district;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

Robert Abbott is hereby appointed to serve the unexpired term of position three on the Sammamish Plateau water and sewer district's board of commissioners until a

qualified person is elected at the next election at which a commissioner normally would be elected.
