STATEMENT OF FACTS:

- Several school districts within unincorporated King County desire to provide supplemental security and law enforcement services for its students and staff.
- The county has the resources to provide such security and law enforcement services.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The county executive is authorized to execute a contract,

substantially in the form of Attachment A to this ordinance, with various unincorporated King County school districts.
