AN ORDINANCE authorizing the King County executive to execute an interlocal agreement with the city of Kirkland regarding the operation of city-owned traffic signals and related intelligent transportation system equipment by the King County road services division.

STATEMENT OF THE FACTS

- 1. NE 124th Street corridor from 100th Avenue NE to SR 202 is a regional arterial that serves both unincorporated King County and city of Kirkland residents.
- 2. The county's intelligent transportation system ("ITS") project, which is identified in the road services division, adopted six-year capital improvement plan as CIP 101496, will improve traffic flow by interconnecting and coordinating the signal system and providing transit signal priority along the corridor.
- 3. The operation of the city-owned traffic signals along the corridor by the road services division is vital to the implementation of the county's project.
- 4. The city of Kirkland approved an interlocal agreement allowing the road services division to operate the city's ITS equipment and traffic signals related to the project on August 16, 2004.
- 5. Chapter 39.34 RCW authorizes the county and the city to enter into an interlocal cooperation agreement such as Attachment A to this ordinance.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The county executive is hereby authorized to execute an interlocal agreement, substantially
