BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The collective bargaining agreement negotiated by and between King County and Washington State Nurses Association (Supervisors and Managers) representing employees in the department of public health, which is Attachment A to this ordinance, is hereby approved and adopted by this reference made
