WHEREAS, on March 14, 2016, Motion 14588 approved the Report on Proposed Funding Allocation Methodology for Human Services Programs ("the report on proposed funding") in response to a proviso in Ordinance 17941, Section 58, and

WHEREAS, Motion 14588 further requested that, within fifteen days after the date on which the final workgroup concludes its deliberations regarding work outlined in the report on proposed funding, the executive transmit to the council the conclusions of the allocation workgroups and a motion approving the final
