AN ORDINANCE authorizing the county executive to sign a twenty-five year lease agreement enabling the Puget Sound Emergency Radio Network project to occupy and use the city of Redmond's education hill site.

STATEMENT OF FACTS:

For the lease from the city of Redmond, located at 10365 172nd Avenue NE, Redmond, Washington, in council district three, the Puget Sound Emergency Radio Network project, with the oversight of the county's facilities management division, has determined that there is not an appropriate county-owned option, and has successfully negotiated a lease with the city of Redmond that will enable the Puget Sound Emergency Radio Network project to use the

education hill site.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The executive is authorized to execute a lease for the education hill site with the city of Redmond, substantially in the form of Attachment A to this ordinance, and to take all actions necessary to implement the terms of the lease.
