A. Implementing prepaid postage on ballot-return envelopes for the August 2018 primary and

November 2018 general elections; and

B. Evaluating the feasibility of providing King County registered voters the option of placing postage

on ballot-return envelopes in order to save county resources. If the concept is feasible, the director of elections

may implement the ballot-return envelope postage options for the August 2018 primary and November 2018 general elections.
