AN ORDINANCE revising the legal description of the annexation of approximately 99.98 acres of land into the King County water district No. 119, known as the Fellingge Annexation, for the purpose of water service; and amending Ordinance 18742, Section 1.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS:

1. On May 7, 2018, the council adopted Ordinance 18742, which approved the annexation of approximately 99.98 acres of land into King County water district No. 119. The executive approved the ordinance on June 19, 2018. Ordinance 18742 became effective on June 29, 2018.
2. Ordinance 18742 contained an incorrect legal description of the annexation area.
3. On August 7, 2018, the clerk of the council received a corrected legal description from the

Washington state Boundary Review Board for King County.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 18742, Section 1, is hereby amended to read as follows:

The annexation of approximately 99.98 acres of land into the King County water district No. 119 for the purpose of providing water service described in Attachment A to ((~~Ordinance 18742~~)) this ordinance is approved. Approval of this proposed annexation is consistent with RCW 57.02.040.
