AN ORDINANCE adopting and ratifying Growth Management Planning Council Motion 18-1.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Findings:

A. Growth Management Planning Council Motion 18-1 outlines best practices jurisdictions can take to facilitate the development and renovation of public schools within the Urban Growth Area.

B. On May 30, 2018, the Growth Management Planning Council unanimously adopted Motion 18-1.
