AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of approximately 205.3 acres of land into King County water district 119, known as the Oppen Annexation, for the purpose of water service.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of approximately 205.3 acres of land into King County water district 119, known as the Oppen Annexation, for the purpose of providing water service was filed with the county council on August 16, 2019.
2. King County water district 119 has approved the proposed transfer in Resolution No. 523, passed on June 5, 2019.
3. King County water district 119 issued a determination of nonsignificance on the proposed annexation dated June 5, 2019.

4. The utilities technical review committee reviewed the King County water district No. 119 comprehensive plan, and found that plan met the criteria for approval. The county approved the most recent plan for the King County water district No. 119 in 2016, as part of Ordinance 18260.

5. The county council held the legally required public hearing and has considered the criteria in RCW 57.02.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation of approximately 205.3 acres of land into King County water district 119 for the purpose of providing water service described in Attachment A to this ordinance is approved. Approval of this proposed annexation is consistent with RCW 57.02.040.

SECTION 2. King County water district 119 is the appropriate entity to serve the area proposed to be annexed.

SECTION 3. Completion of this annexation does not constitute county approval or disapproval of any other permits, certifications or actions necessary to provide service to this annexation area.
