## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

## **SECTION 1.** Findings:

A. Growth Management Planning Council Motion 19-1 amends the Urban Growth Boundary map in the 2012 King County Countywide Planning Policies to add the Greater Downtown Kirkland Urban Center as an urban center.

- B. On July 24, 2019, the city of Kirkland briefed the Growth Management Planning Council on the details of the proposed Greater Downtown Kirkland urban center.
- C. On September 25, 2019, the Growth Management Planning Council unanimously adopted Motion 19-1.

SECTION 2. The amendment to the 2012 King County Countywide Planning

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Policies, as shown in Attachment A to this ordinance, is hereby adopted by King County and ratified on behalf of the population of unincorporated King County.
