A MOTION acknowledging receipt of a report on the management of biosolids, including a description and evaluation of alternative options for the use of biosolids prepared in accordance with the 2019-2020 Biennial Budget Ordinance, Ordinance 18835, Section 108, as amended by Ordinance 18930, Section 72, Proviso P3.

WHEREAS, the King County 2019-2020 Biennial Budget Ordinance, Ordinance 18835, Section 108, as amended by Ordinance 18930, Section 72, Proviso P3, states that \$100,000 shall not be expended or encumbered until the executive transmits a report on the management of biosolids generated in the processing of wastewater at county facilities, and a motion that acknowledges receipt of the report and the motion is passed by the council, and
