WHEREAS, RCW 29A.32.280 provides that for each measure from a jurisdiction that is included in a local voters' pamphlet, the legislative authority of that jurisdiction shall formally appoint a committee to prepare arguments advocating voter approval of the measure and a committee to prepare arguments advocating voter rejection of the measure, and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 19267 provides for submission to the qualified electors of King County at a special election to be held on August 3, 2021, a proposed property tax levy for the purpose of funding prevention and early intervention strategies and a capital grants program to improve the health and well-being of children, youth and their communities;
