



of community and human services to connect individuals and families in the unincorporated urban and rural areas experiencing, or at risk of experiencing, homelessness with housing options and other services aimed at reducing instances of homelessness, and develop a report.

B. The report should include:

1. A list of current housing and homelessness service providers in King County, including a delineation of which housing service providers serve unincorporated urban and rural areas;
2. A needs analysis identifying the number and size of homeless outreach teams that would be necessary to serve the unincorporated areas of King County, and identifying the skills and expertise needed by members of the homeless outreach teams;
3. An update on the creation of the homeless outreach teams required in section A of this motion, including plans for coordination with the King County Regional Homelessness Authority; and
4. Funding required to establish homeless outreach teams.

C. The executive should electronically file the report, as well as any necessary legislation to further the creation or implementation of homeless outreach teams, no later than October 30, 2021, with the clerk of the council, who shall retain an electronic copy and provide an electronic copy to all councilmembers.
