BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The memorandum of agreement regarding Maintenance Painter Apprentice Program negotiated by and between King County and Amalgamated Transit Union, Local 587 (Metro Transit Department) representing employees in the metro transit department, which is Attachment A to this ordinance, is hereby approved and adopted by this reference made a part hereof.
