
AN ORDINANCE authorizing the county executive to enter into interagency agreements with various unincorporated King County school districts to provide supplemental security and law enforcement services.

STATEMENT OF FACTS:

- 1. Several school districts within unincorporated King County desire to provide supplemental security and law enforcement services for its students and staff.
- 2. The county has the resources to provide such security and law enforcement services.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> The county executive is authorized to execute a contract,



substantially in the form of Attachment A to this ordinance, with various unincorporated King County school districts.
