AN ORDINANCE approving and adopting the memorandum of agreement regarding a productivity program negotiated by and between King County and Service Employees International Union, Local 925 (Department of Executive

Services - Facilities Management Division) representing employees in the department of executive services; and establishing the effective date of said agreement.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The memorandum of agreement regarding the full implementation of a productivity program negotiated between King County and Service Employees International Union, Local 925 (Department of Executive Services - Facilities Management Division) and enacted on December 16, 2005 through Ordinance 15364 representing employees in the department of executive services and attached hereto is hereby approved and adopted by this reference made a part hereof.

SECTION 2. Terms and conditions of said agreement shall be effective from January 1, 2006, through and including December 31, 2007.
