Title: A MOTION reaffirming the council's decision to hold all-mail elections beginning in 2008 after certain

identified conditions have been met, establishing the council's preference to conduct all-mail elections using the current ballot tabulation equipment and software, authorizing the executive to continue working with vendors on proposals for the purchase of new ballot tabulation equipment and software, and providing that the county's 2008 state legislative agenda should include a request to revise state law to allow individual counties to adopt by ordinance customized procedures for conducting post-

election audits.
