## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> The collective bargaining agreement and two memoranda of understanding negotiated between King County and Service Employees International Union, Local 925 (Wastewater Treatment Division) representing employees in the department of natural resources and parks and attached hereto is hereby approved and adopted by this reference made a part hereof.

SECTION 2. Terms and conditions of said agreements shall be effective from November 1, 2006, through and including June 30, 2009.
