AN ORDINANCE authorizing the vacation of a portion of the 68th Avenue NE
right-of-way, File V-2607; Petitioner: John Postma.

STATEMENT OF FACTS:

1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a portion of the 68th Avenue NE right-of-way hereinafter described.
2. The department of transportation notified the various utility companies serving the area and has been advised that easements have either been obtained or are not required within the vacation area.
3. A sewer easement has been recorded for the Northshore Utility District, under King County recording number 20080130001424.
4. The department of transportation records indicate that King County has not been maintaining

the subject portion of the 68th Avenue NE right-of-way. The records indicate that no public funds have been expended for its acquisition.

5. The department of transportation considers the subject portion of the right-of-way useless as part of the county road system and believes the public would benefit by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.

6. The right-of-way is classified as "C-Class" and, in accordance with K.C.C. 14.40.020, the compensation due King County is based on fifty percent of the assessed value of the subject right-of-way, which was determined from records of the department of assessments. King County is in receipt of \$14,766.83 from the petitioner.

Due notice was given in the manner provided by law and hearings were held by the office of the hearing examiner on the 27th day of May 2009 and the 24th day of June 2009.

In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the subject vacation the council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of King County to grant said petition.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The council, on the effective date of this ordinance, hereby vacates and abandons that portion of the 68th Avenue NE right-of-way as conveyed to King County by the recording of the Plat of Lake Park to the City of Seattle recorded in Volume 11 of Plats, on Page 67, records of King County, Washington as described below:

That portion of the northeasterly half of the 68th Avenue NE right-of-way, dedicated as Maple Street in the Plat of Lake Park to the City of Seattle, recorded in Volume 11 of Plats, Page 67, records of King County, Washington, abutting and adjacent to the southwesterly line of the south 240.60 feet of Lot 11, of Block 11, of said plat.

Located in the Northwest Quarter of Section 25, of Township 26 North, Range 4 East, Willamette Meridian, King County, Washington.
