WHEREAS, in accordance with K.C.C. 2.53.021, appointments to the citizens' elections oversight committee are subject to confirmation by the full council by motion, and

WHEREAS, on July 26, 2022, in accordance with K.C.C. 2.53.021, the employment and administration committee reappointed Jayson Todd Morris to the citizens' elections oversight committee, for a three-year term to expire July 31, 2025;
