WHEREAS, the citizens' elections oversight committee help to ensure that accountability and

performance of the department of elections is provided in a transparent manner that is meaningful to King

County residents, and

WHEREAS, in accordance with K.C.C. 2.53.021, the employment and administration committee

appoints members to the citizens' elections oversight committee, and

WHEREAS, in accordance with K.C.C. 2.53.021, appointments to the citizens' elections oversight

committee are subject to confirmation by the full council by motion, and

WHEREAS, on July 26, 2022, in accordance with K.C.C. 2.53.021, the employment and administration committee reappointed Hillary Coleman to the citizens' elections oversight committee, for a three-year term to expire September 30, 2025;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The reappointment of Hillary Coleman to the citizens' elections oversight committee as a representative of King County registered voters, for a three-year term to expire on September 30, 2025, is confirmed."
