AN ORDINANCE adopting a new concurrency test results map in accordance with K.C.C. 14.70.270.

STATEMENT OF FACTS:

1. K.C.C. 14.70.270 requires the concurrency test results map to be reviewed and updated in even-numbered years, or when directed by the council by motion, and be submitted to council for approval by ordinance no later than July 31.
2. To meet the requirement for 2022, concurrency testing has been completed and evaluated for each travel shed. That resulted in a change to one of the travel sheds requiring an update to the current concurrency test results map.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The concurrency test results map displayed in Attachment A to this ordinance is adopted as the official concurrency test results map for King County.
