AN ORDINANCE approving and adopting the memorandum of agreement negotiated by and between King County and the Public Safety Employees Union representing Communications Specialists Supervisors employees in the King County Sheriff's Office; and establishing the effective date of the agreement.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The memorandum of agreement negotiated by and between King County and the Public Safety Employees Union representing employees in the King County Sheriff's Office, which is Attachment A to this ordinance, is hereby approved and adopted by this reference made a part hereof.

SECTION 2. Terms and conditions of the agreement shall be effective from September 17, 2022, through and including December 31, 2024.
