A MOTION confirming the reappointment of Paul Guppy as a representative of
an independent research and policy institute to the King County citizens' elections

WHEREAS, in Ordinances 14711 and 15157, the metropolitan King County council established
citizens' election oversight committees to review the conduct of elections in King County, to identify problems
and to make recommendations, and

WHEREAS, those committees have consistently provided invaluable service to county voters and
county government, and

WHEREAS, in Ordinance 15453, the King County council established a new citizens' elections
oversight committee and adopted criteria for membership on the committee;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The reappointment of Paul Guppy to the King County citizens' elections oversight

committee, as a representative of an independent research and policy institute for a term to expire on September 18, 2012, is hereby confirmed.
