AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of approximately 187 acres of land into the Sammamish Plateau water and sewer district, known as the Overdale Annexation, for the purpose of water and sewer service.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS:

- 1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of approximately 187 acres of land into the Sammamish Plateau water and sewer district, known as Overdale Annexation, for the purpose of providing water and sewer service was filed with the county council on January 27, 2011.
- 2. Sammamish Plateau water and sewer district has found the petition for transfer to be sufficient and has concurred with the proposed transfer in Resolution No. 3977, passed on December 6, 2010.
- 3. The Sammamish Plateau water and sewer district filed a determination of nonsignificance on the proposed annexation dated September 22, 2010.
- 4. The utilities technical review committee recommended county council approval of the proposed annexation.
- 5. The county council held the legally required public hearing and has considered the criteria in RCW 57.02.040.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation of approximately 187 acres of land into the Sammamish Plateau water and sewer district for the purpose of providing water and sewer service described in Attachment A to this ordinance is approved. Approval of this proposed annexation is consistent with RCW 57.02.040.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> The Sammamish Plateau water and sewer district is the appropriate entity to serve the area proposed to be annexed.

SECTION 3. Completion of this annexation does not constitute county approval

or disapproval of any other permits, certifications or actions necessary to provide service to this annexation area.
